- 1938 - She died Jan Sunday 4/9/1938 - Buried in Humenne.

He became organist at Hazelton Pa when Gymbek went back to Europe. Thus becoming 2nd Slovak organist USA.

Georgius Gymbek lived in Slovaki - District of Vranor on the way to Strupske + Prevor - County of Zemplin.
